

2025 Environment Day: PT Dermaga Perkasapratama Plants Mangroves with the Local Community



Balikpapan, 2025 — To commemorate the 2025 World Environment Day, PT Dermaga Perkasapratama (DPP) took concrete action by planting 1,000 mangroves on 10 June 2025 around the coastal area of Balikpapan Coal Terminal in East Kalimantan.
